Clarin.dk:

- Part of DIGHUMLAB:
 - National infrastructure initiative, launched 2012
 - Partners now: 4 Danish Universities, will be extended
- Repository for resources and tools for the humanities
- All metadata are publicly accessible
- Single sign-on through WAYF (Where Are You From) using shibboleth
 - All research institutions in Denmark can use WAYF
- Access: Resources are public, academic or restricted
 - Licenses are currently clarin.dk-specific, based on CLARIN work in preparatory phase
 - Data provider accepts license when depositing
- PID in metadata (locally defined)
- Version control of resources
- Repository implemented using eSciDoc, based on Fedora repository system

- Metadata formats determined in collaboration with content providers
- OAI-PMH harvesting: currently oai_dc and OLAC, to be extended with CMDI
- Resources are being deposited, more texts...
- More resource types can be added









Services

- Metadata search, all metadata are public
- Download of resources, if user accepts license!
- Integrated tools which can process resources in repository, currently text tools
- Workflow service: user selects resources and goal, workflow assistant plans which tools to use to fulfil the users goal
- Deposit of resources
- Content search facilities, to be extended
- OAI-PMH
- to be extended ...
 - Search in corpora
 - Combined search in metadata, text and annotations
