ISOcat:

Data Category Registry defining widely accepted data categories (DCs)

Link with CLARIN



Part of the CLARIN task:

- locating (annotated) resources
- relating such resources

► ISOcat could be very useful for doing so, especially in combination with its kittens RELcat and SCHEMAcat

Use of ISOcat



- ISOcat as is allows a lot of freedom to its users. There are guidelines, but following these is not really enforced.
- In CLARIN-NL/VL we do enforce use of a set of guidelines, i.e., a list of "do's and don'ts"
- ▶ not following these will make a DC not acceptable (ISOcat content management)

Some examples



Definitions should be

- To the point
- Language/project neutral
- Unambiguous

• ...

► as general as possible, as specific as needed

JOIN



ISOcat (plus RELcat and SCHEMAcat):

- ► these devices will only work well when their content is <u>sound</u>
- ► their performance will be optimal when the same strategies are followed by all CLARIN parties involved
- **▶ ▶ ▶** Collaboration
- ▶ ▶ JOINt content management

Ideally



- Every ERIC member using ISOcat appoints a national ISOcat content co-ordinator, and
- These co-ordinators join JOIN

If not, centers or even projects could join JOIN
