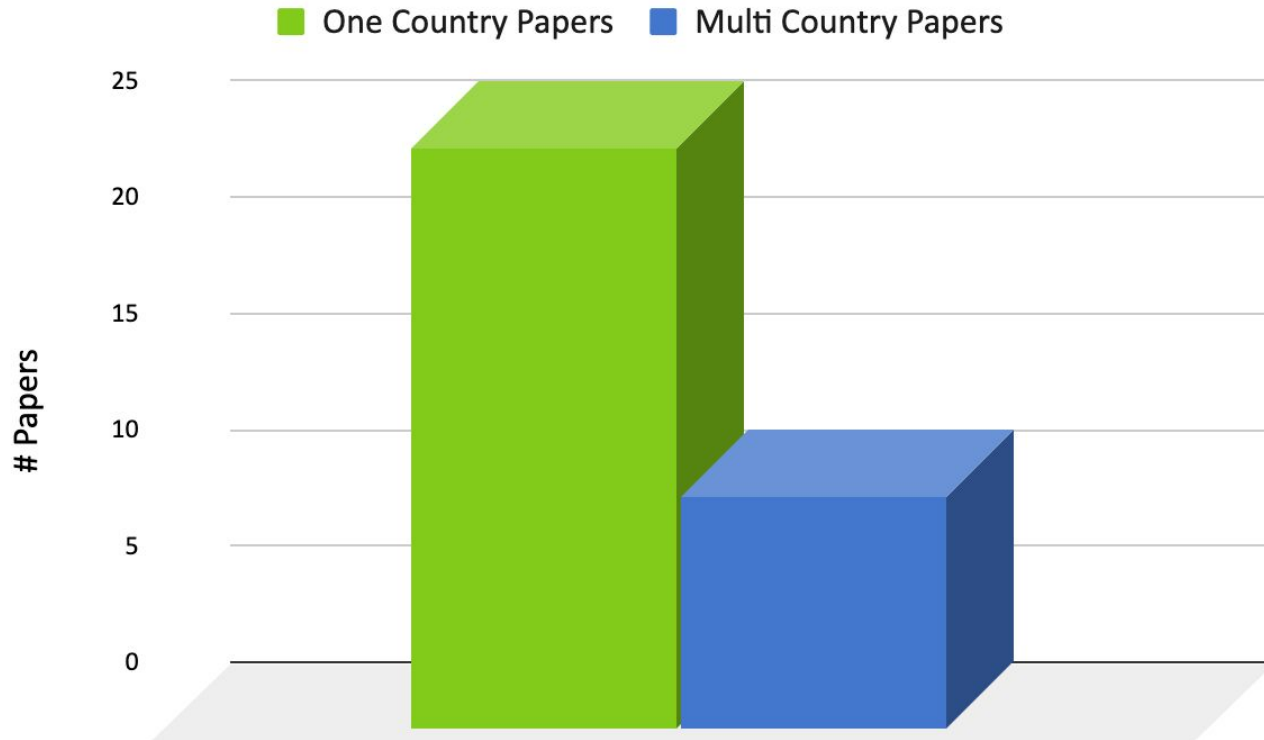

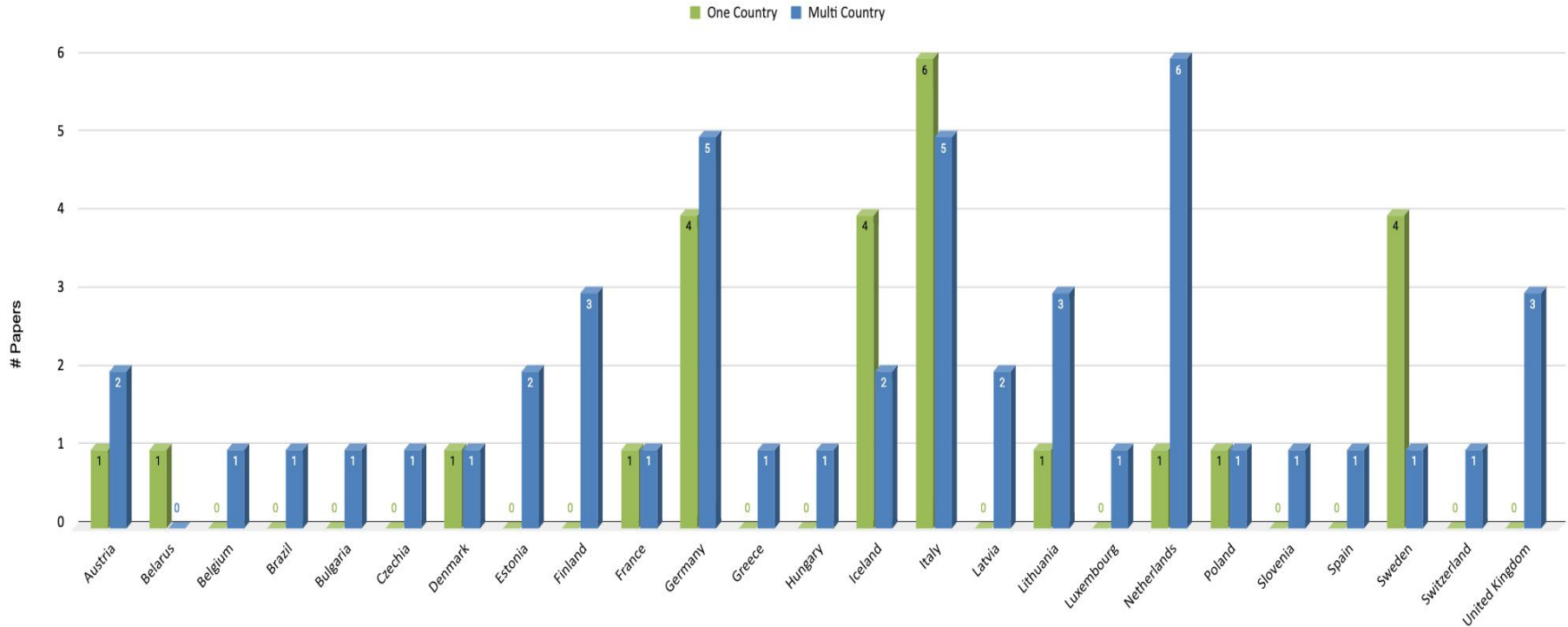

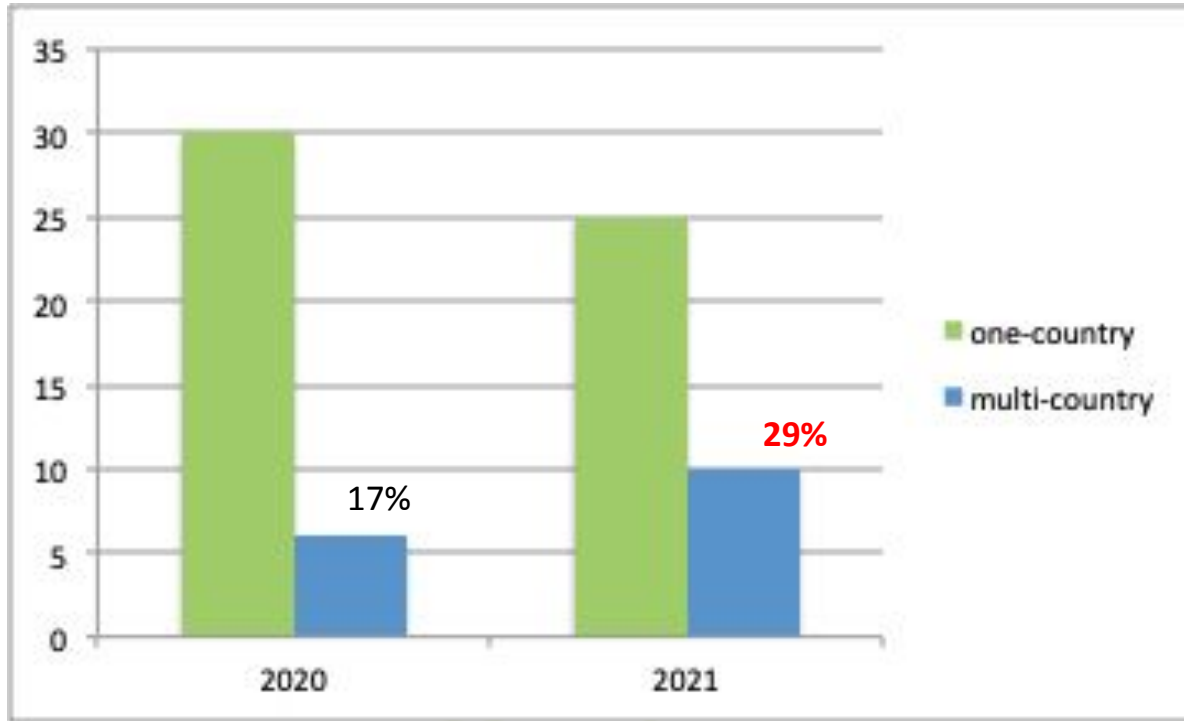
CLARIN2021 One- vs Multi- Country Papers



CLARIN2021 One- vs Multi- Country Papers (per Country)

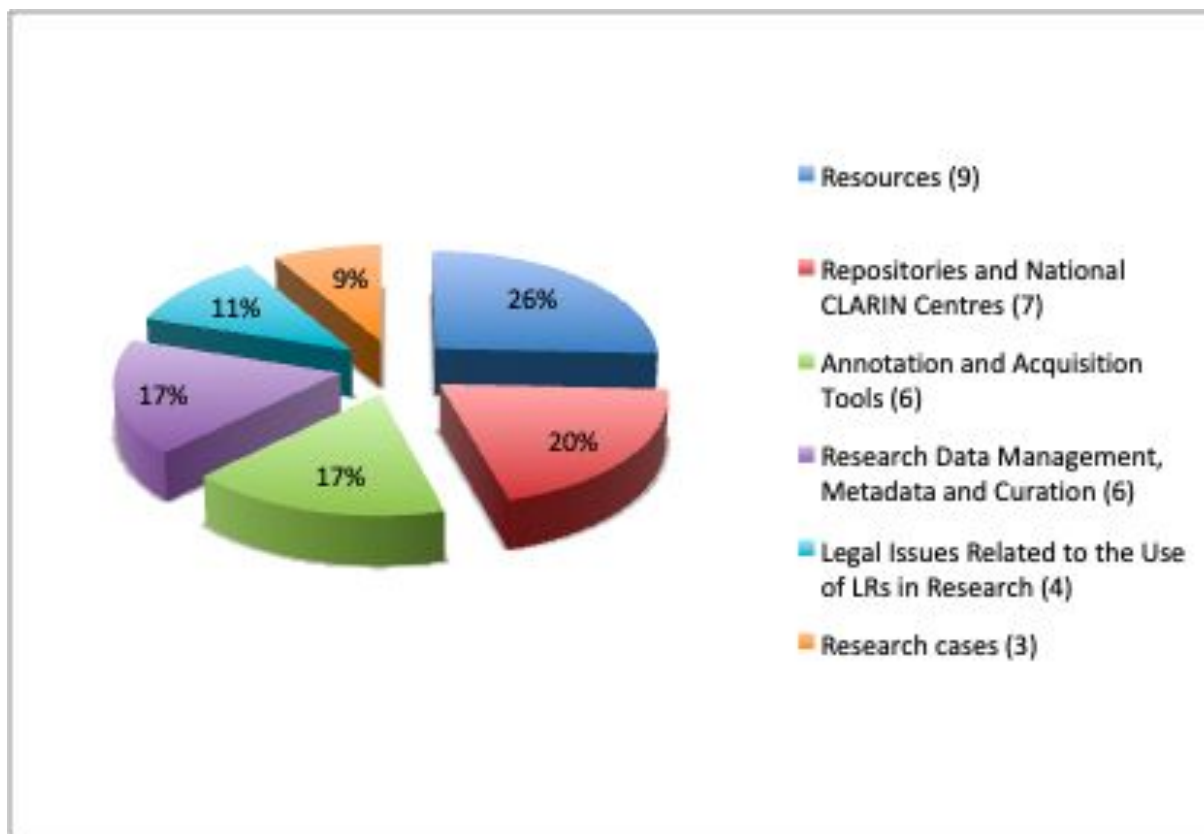


CLARIN2020 vs CLARIN2021 Multi-country Collaboration
