




Oral source is seen as complementary and equal to textual source

- Social history, give 'voice' to underprivileged groups in society
- Corroborate evidence, no editing, recording is preserved
- Truth? Reliability? Reconstructing facts and events?

Oral source is considered as a different genre

- Under the influence of *The Cultural Turn* oral history interviews are more and more seen as an interactive process of attributing meaning to events

- Truth and reliability become irrelevant?




