# Interactive Dynamic Presentation (IDP) at work

Go to <http://wittgensteinonline.no/> and create:

- 1) A linear transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-101
- 2) A diplomatic transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-101
- 3) A diplomatic transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-101, displaying the text's original line breaks
- 4) A diplomatic transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-101, displaying the text in chronological order
- 5) A linear transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-105, displaying all and only the text that by W. was marked with section mark «/»
- 6) A linear transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ms-118, highlighting passages in code («Geheimschrift»)
- 7) A transcription version of Wittgenstein Nachlass Ts-226, displaying typewritten text only (i.e. without revisions in hand)

- 1) All references to Mozart
- 2) All references to Mozart in the Correspondence (“Letter or postcard”)
- 3) All references to Mozart’s “Zauberflöte”
- 4) All documents published in “Culture and Value” and containing a reference to Mozart
- 5) All documents stemming from the period 1947-03-29 — 1947-03-30
- 6) All documents stemming from the period 1947-03-29 — 1947-03-30 that refer to Chopin
- 7) A list of variants for remark Ms-115,118[2]

## WiTTFind at work

Go to <http://wittfind.cis.uni-muenchen.de/> and find

- 1) All occurrences of “schreiben”
- 2) All occurrences of “schreiben” from the period 1933-1951
- 3) All occurrences of “schreiben” from the period 1933-1951, contained in “Bände”
- 4) All occurrences of “schreiben”, preceded by “Brief” (“Brief schreiben”)
- 5) All occurrences of “schreiben”, preceded by a noun (“<N> schreiben”; see <http://wittfind.cis.uni-muenchen.de/?help>)
- 6) All occurrences of “schreiben”, preceded by a term designating a human (“<HUM> schreiben”; see <http://wittfind.cis.uni-muenchen.de/?help>)
- 7) All occurrences of “nachdenken”
